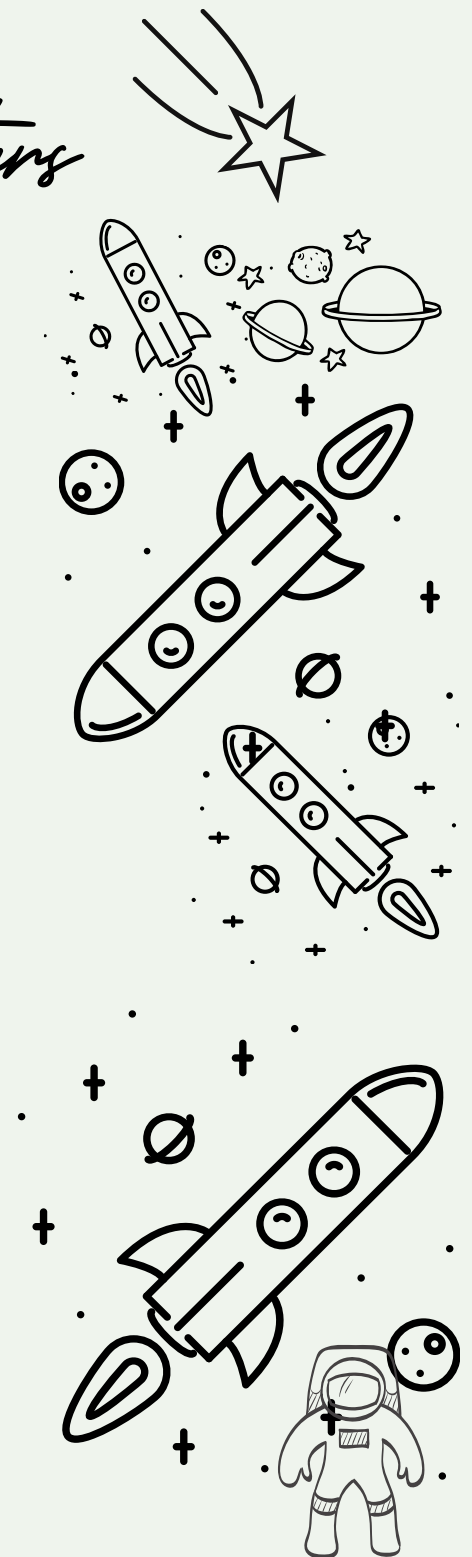

## Jupiter Jello

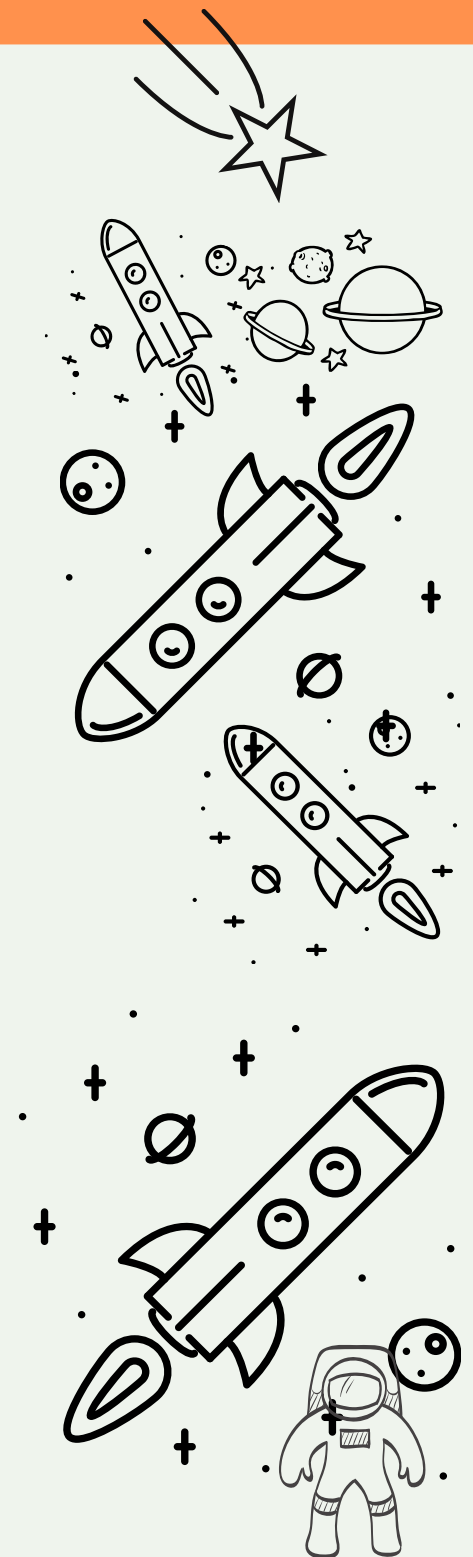
### INGREDIENTS

- 2 1/2 - tablespoons of gelatin
- 140 ml (1/2 cup) - of bone broth
- Optional 1/4 - teaspoon of garlic paste

Alternative Recipe - Substitute bone broth with mashed Blueberries

### METHOD

- 1 Add bone broth to a low heat sauce pan
- 2 Add in garlic paste (optional)
- 3 Add the gelatin
- 4 Heat gently on a low heat for 10 mins until all the gelatin has dissolved. Stir regularly
- 5 Once it is ready, pour into your mould before it cools
- 6 Leave for 15 minutes until they begin to set, then place in the fridge. They should set like soft rubber

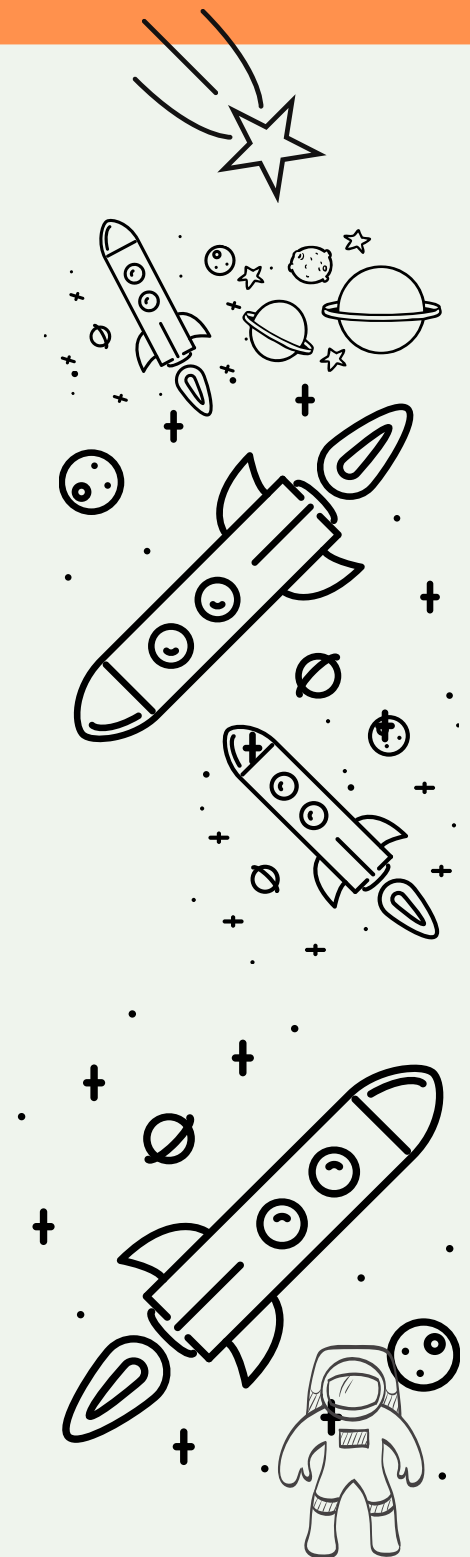
## Crater Crunch

## INGREDIENTS

- 3 - Eggs
- 3 - Weetabix
- 1 - Tin of sardines in oil

## METHOD

- 1 Mix and mash all the ingredients in a bowl
- 2 Roll into small balls or add to a silicone mould
- 3 Cook in the oven at 190 degrees / gas mark 5 for 15-20minutes.
- 4 When they are cooked allow to cool and enjoy

## Milky Moons

### INGREDIENTS

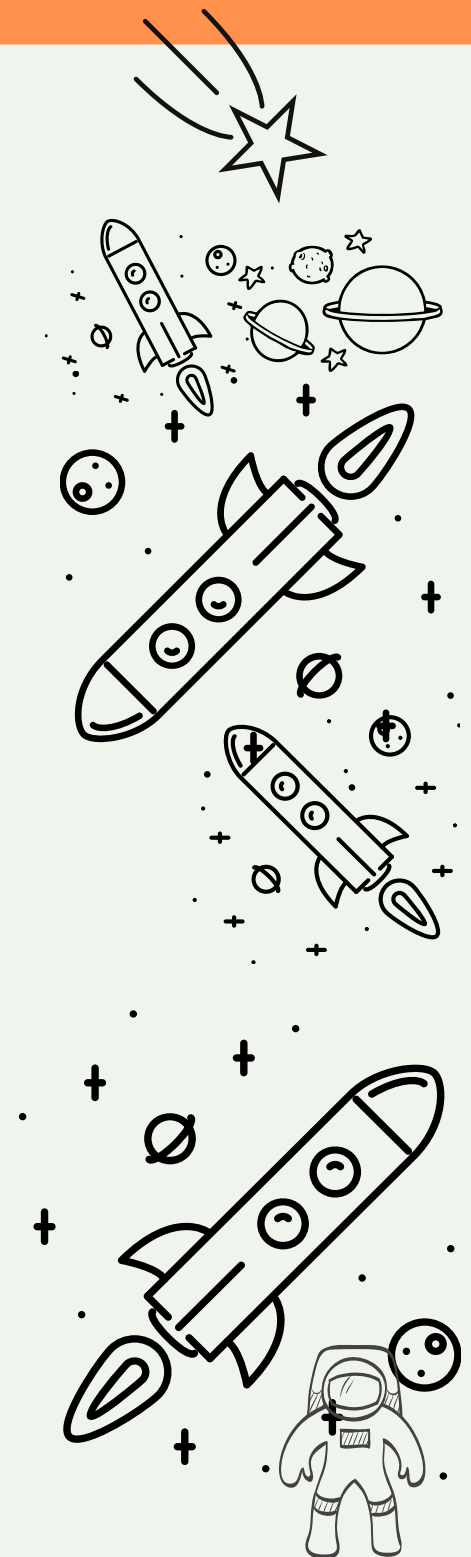
- 2 cups - Whole wheat flour or rolled oats
- 2 (4oz) jars of pureed baby food (be careful to select low sugar options) - beef, blueberry, sweet potato, chicken

### FROSTING

- 1 - Small tub of cream cheese
- 2 Tablespoons - Honey

### METHOD

- 1 Pre heat the oven to 180 degrees / gas mark 4
- 2 Mix ingredients together to form a stiff dough, add extra flour or water if needed
- 3 On a lightly floured surface, roll out evenly until its about 1/4 inch thick. Use a cookie cutter or shape into the desired shape.
- 4 Add to a baking tray and cook for 20-25 minutes
- 5 Allow to cool and add frosting if desired
- 6 Blend the cream cheese and honey, spread on the cooled cookie. Store in the fridge

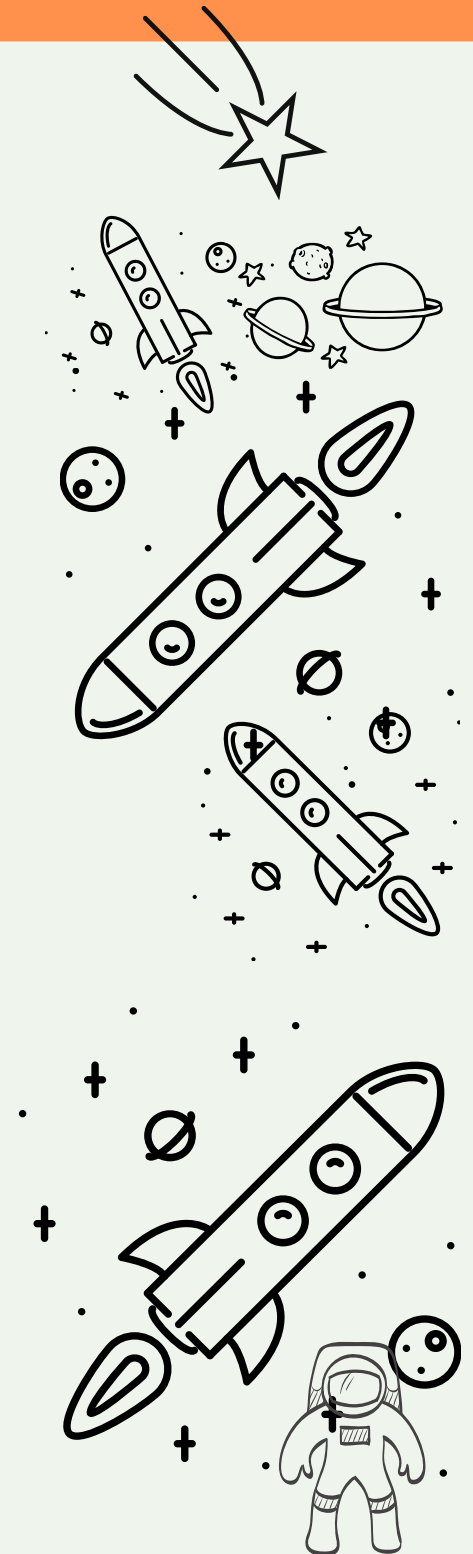
## Mars Mud

## INGREDIENTS

- Dog friendly chocolate
- Cottage Cheese/Cream Cheese

## METHOD

- 1 Break the chocolate into small pieces and add to a microwave safe bowl
- 2 Heat on 30 second increments, stirring thoroughly inbetween sessions
- 3 Mix the melted chocolate into the cheese
- 4 Allow to cool before serving

## INGREDIENTS

A selection of brightly coloured dog safe food e.g.

Carrots

Blueberries

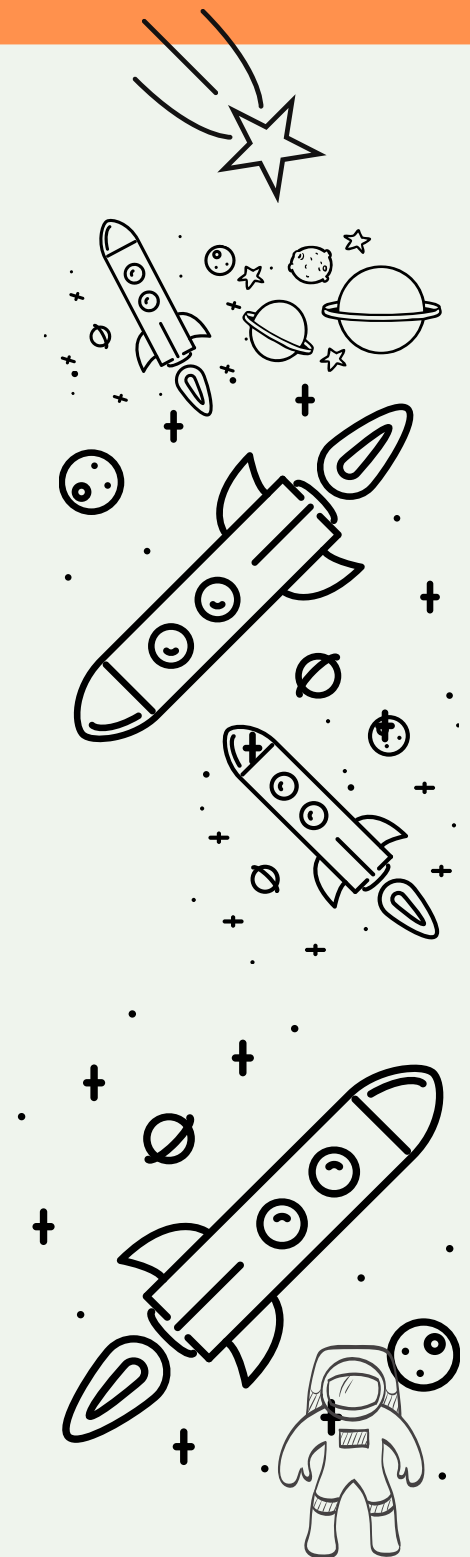
Strawberries

Peas

You need two plastic bowls that fit inside one another - one large and one smaller.

## METHOD

- 1 Half fill a bowl with water
- 2 Add a selection of treats
- 3 Immerse a smaller bowl in the large bowl by filling with water (or a weight of some kind)
- 4 Freeze

## Planet Pizza

## INGREDIENTS

### **Crust:**

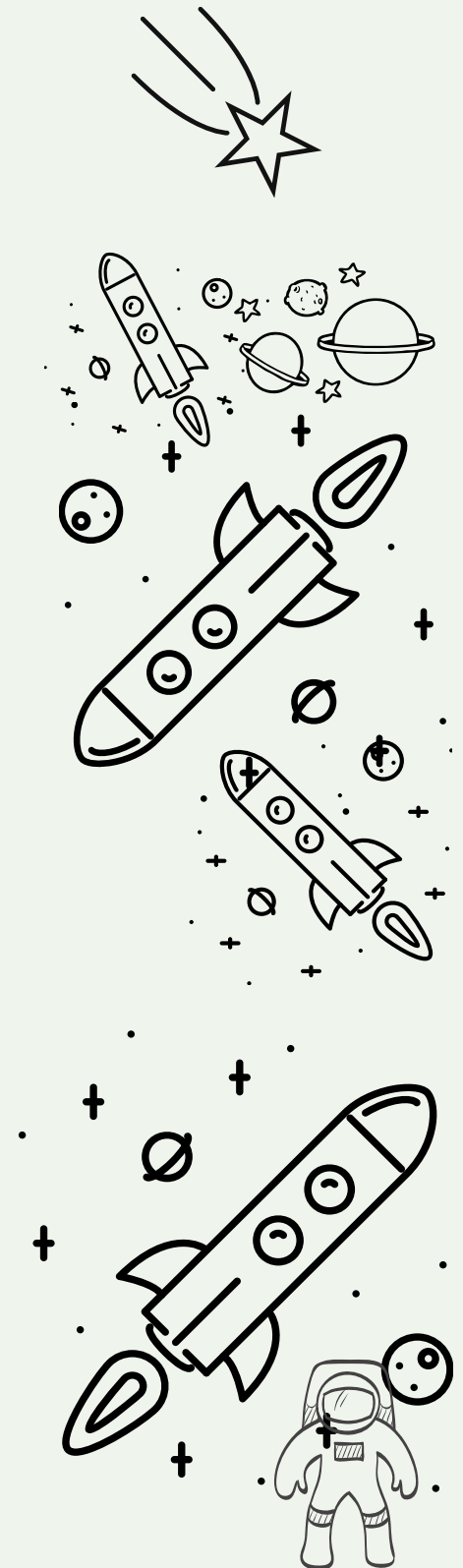
- 1 cup - Coconut flour
- 1 tsp - Dried basil
- 1 tsp - Dried oregano
- 1 tsp - Dried parsley
- 1 tsp - Dried basil
- 1 egg
- 1 cup - Unsalted chicken broth

### **Ideas for toppings:**

- Mashed, cooked sweet potato
- Low fat mozzarella cheese
- Grated carrot
- Plain cooked meat

## METHOD

- 1** Preheat oven to 400 degrees Spray deep dish pie pan with non stick cooking spray
- 2** In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, basil, parsley and oregano.
- 3** In a separate bowl, whisk the egg and stir in the chicken broth.
- 4** Make a well in the dry mixture and pour in the wet ingredients.
- 5** Stir together until combined.
- 6** Spread crust mixture in the pie pan and press down with your hands.
- 7** Spread sweet potato mixture if desired on crust and top with dog friendly toppings of your choice and cheese.
- 8** Bake in the oven for 30 minutes or until the cheese is browned. Take out of the oven and let cool completely before serving.

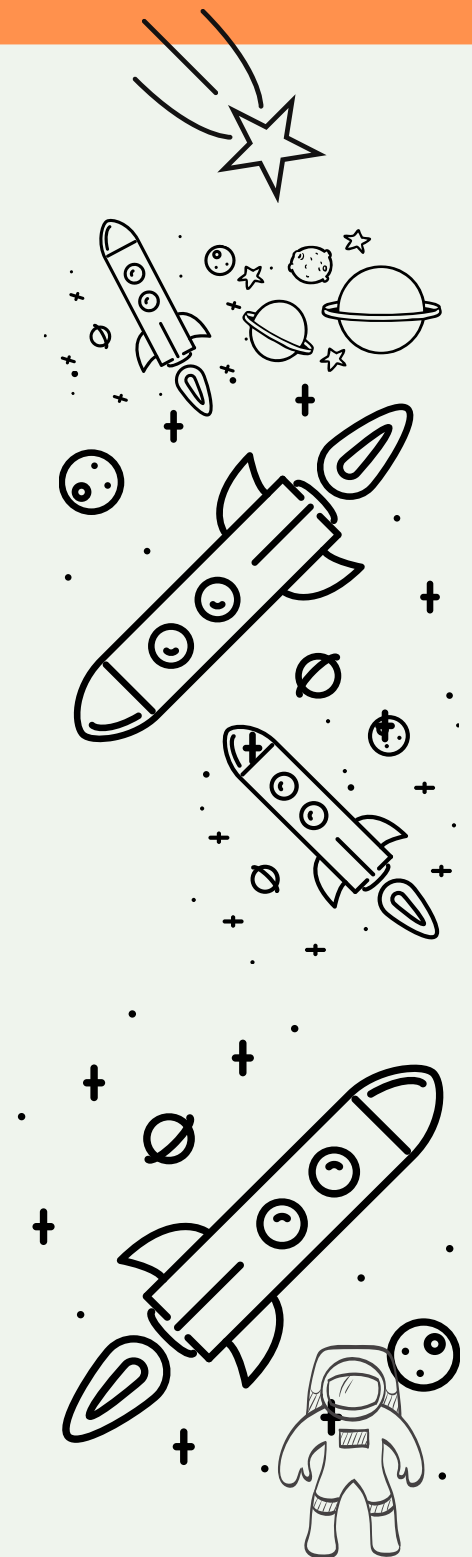
# Pancake Planets

## INGREDIENTS

- 100g - Plain flour
- 2 Large eggs
- 300ml - Milk
- 1 tbsp - Sunflower or vegetable oil, plus a little extra for frying

## METHOD

- 1** Put all ingredients into a bowl or large jug, then whisk to a smooth batter.
- 2** Set aside for 30 mins to rest if you have time or start cooking straight away.
- 3** Set a medium frying pan or crêpe pan over a medium heat and carefully wipe it with some oiled kitchen paper.
- 4** When hot, cook your pancakes for 1 min on each side until golden, serve once cool enough.

- Be creative!

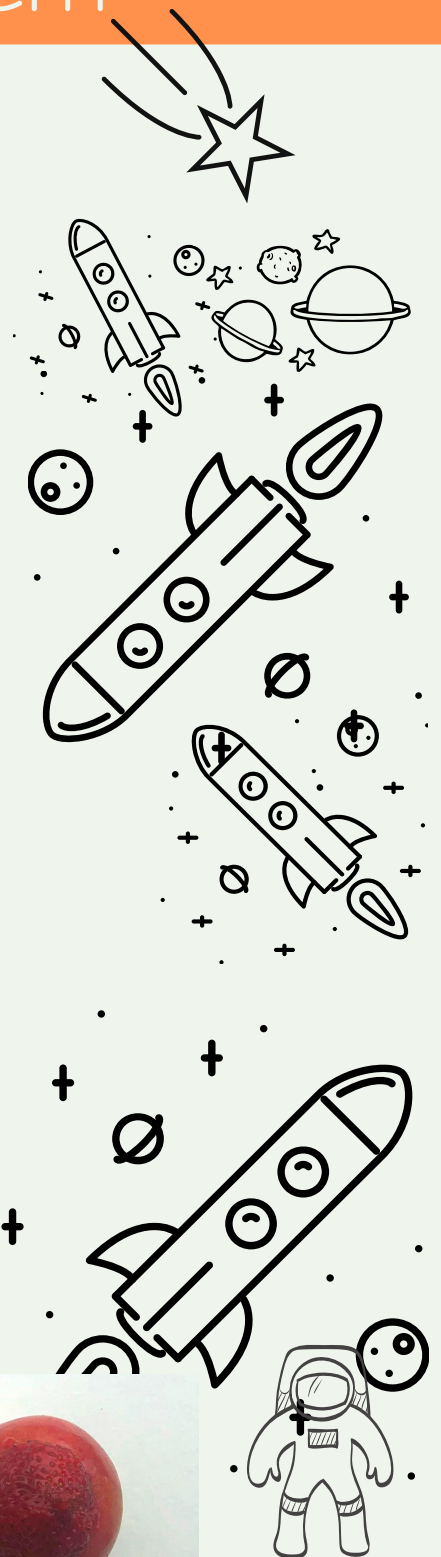
### METHOD

## Rocket Kebabs

### INGREDIENTS

- Lamb spaghetti
- Fruits or vegetables cut into rocket shapes, e.g.:
- Strawberries
  - Carrots
  - Banana
  - Melon

### METHOD

- 1 Cut the fruit and vegetables into rocket shapes
- 2 Using lamb spaghetti as a kebab stick, thread the fruit and vegetables on to look like a rocket
